Publications

Requirements:

- Columns should be between 900-1,100 words long and single-spaced in Word. No footnotes/end notes, and case citations should be limited to just the case name.
- Each column should contain a suggested headline as well as bylines for the authors. An example of an acceptable byline includes:

- All columns should be co-written by one CLM member (outside counsel) and one CLM fellow (industry/vendor rep), and a **high-resolution headshot** must be included for both.
- Both authors must be a current fellow or member of CLM.

Deadline:

Each column should be delivered 4-6 weeks in advance of the issue month. Suggested deadlines include:

December Print Issue: Due October 22, 2021
